5. Novelty ( 5 marks )

3. A poster should be an individual effort of a student.
4. Paper size should be A3,A2 or poster paper.

5. Mention students name and class, section on the right – hand side bottom of the sheet.
6. Poster should be neat and clean.
7. Each participant can submit only one poster.
8. Normal camera picture only is acceptable.

  - II. School Memories.
  - III. Mahatma Gandhi & Shastri Ji

2. Originality
3. Artistic composition
4. Creativity

## **Speech competition**

### **Class IX & X**

- Speech competition shall be conducted for students of classes IX & X
- Students are free to make a speech based on the “Life of Mahatma Gandhi and Lal Bahadur Shastri.”
- The criteria for judgment shall be as follows:
  1. **Knowledge** – understanding the topic; research; amount of work involved in preparation.
  2. **Originality** – the speech should reflect the work of the student. The information should not be synthesized or copied from a book or internet.
  3. **Organization** – ideas should be well organized (introduction/ Development of ideas/ conclusion).
  4. **Utilization of time** – speech should be of appropriate length. Right amount of information should be given within the given time i.e. ‘Three minutes’
  5. **Style** – style shall be graded using the parameters such as clarity in speech, fluency, body language (gestures) and eloquence ( interest and enthusiasm for the topic ).
